#### **Contract Agreement for Services**

This **CONTRACT AGREEMENT** made on the \_\_\_\_\_\_ day of <u>December</u> 2022 between the **OFFICE OF TRANSPORTATION COOPERATIVES** with principal address at 5<sup>th</sup> Floor Main, Ben-Lor Building, 1184 Quezon Avenue, Brgy. Paligsahan, Quezon City 1103, the Procuring Entity (hereinafter called the "**Entity**") and **ARM CORPORATE SECURITY SERVICES, INC.** with office address at 28 Gladiola Street, Roxas District, Quezon City, Metro Manila 1103, the Supplier (hereinafter called the "**Security Service Provider**"):

WHEREAS, based on the result of the OTC-BAC meeting conducted last 27 December 2022 for the Procurement of Security Services for CY 2023 for the Office of Transportation Cooperatives, the Entity subsequently accepted and duly approved the amount of Three Hundred Forty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Pesos and Sixteen Centavos (PhP 347,570.16), inclusive of appropriate EWT and VAT withholding taxes (hereinafter called the "Contract Price") for the engagement of a Security Agency with one (1) Security Personnel for twelve (12) months, from January 2023 to December 2023 pursuant to OTC-Bids and Awards Committee Resolution No. 012, series of 2022.

#### 1. Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

Additional requirements for the completion of this Contract shall be provided in the **Special Conditions of Contract (SCC).** 

#### 2. Advance Payment and Terms of Payment

- 2.1. Advance payment of the contract amount is provided under Annex "D" of the revised 2016 IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 2.2. The Entity is allowed to determine the terms of payment on the partial or staggered delivery of the Goods procured, provided such partial payment shall correspond to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The terms of payment are indicated in the SCC.

#### 3. Performance Security

Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award by the Bidder from the Entity but in no case later than prior to the signing of the Contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

#### 4. Inspection and Tests

The Entity or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Project specifications at no extra cost to the Entity in accordance with the Generic Procurement Manual. In addition to tests in the SCC, Section IV (Technical Specifications) shall specify what inspections and/or tests the Entity requires, and where they are to be conducted. The Entity shall notify the Security Service Provider in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives retained for these purposes.

All reasonable facilities and assistance for the inspection and testing of Goods, including access to drawings and production data, shall be provided by the Security Service Provider to the authorized inspectors at no charge to the Entity.

#### 5. Warranty

- 6.1. In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Security Service Provider, a warranty shall be required from the Security Service Provider as provided under Section 62.1 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 6.2. The Entity shall promptly notify the Security Service Provider in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the Security Service Provider shall, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof without cost to the Entity, pursuant to the Generic Procurement Manual.

#### 6. Liability of the Security Service Provider

The Security Service Provider's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

If the Security Service Provider is a joint venture, all partners to the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable to the Entity.
