

**SUBJECT :** **PUVMP ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2023**

**DATE :** **2 JANUARY 2024**

The Department of Transportation has transferred to the Office of Transportation Cooperatives an amount of Four (4) Million Pesos on 21 September 2023 per duly executed Memorandum of Agreement and approved Program of Work for the Operation of OTC-Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program Project Management Office.

With this, the Agency was able to hire personnel under Job Order/Contract of Service engagement on 20 September 2023. These Job Order personnel under the PUVMP Program assisted the Operations Division in the conduct of Orientation activities on PUVMP Social Support Programs and Fleet Management and in screening and verifying of beneficiaries to ensure compliance with the requirements of the programs, prior to endorsement to DOTr. They also perform coordination tasks with LGUs and accredited Transport Cooperatives nationwide.

After a period of one month and with the assessment of the Team taking into consideration the timeframe and other factors, the Agency has revised/adjusted the Program of Work (POW) based on the 3-month implementation period and submitted the same to DOTr for approval. The revisions and/or adjustments that we considered include, among others, the following:

1. Hiring of 1 Driver (SG-6) and 1 Audio Visual (SG-10) in lieu of the proposed hiring of One (1) SG-15 Project Development Officer II;
2. On the existing activities, some tasks details were modified like reduction on the number of personnel involved in the activities, prolonged/extended working days to cover the tasks, mode of transportation and adjustments in the schedule of events/undertakings to suit the new timeline;
3. Supplemental/additional PUVMP-related undertakings such as:
  - a. Increase in the budget on the involvement of the Agency in other PUVMP-related engagement activities from the previous Php40,000.00 to Php100,000.00 due to the expected rise in the number of invitations for PUVMP promotion, dialogues, consultations, events, etc. that needed to be attended and included;
  - b. Inclusion of the PUVMP Year-End Assessment activity; and
  - c. Adjustments on the Other Administrative Expenses portion of the POW as a result of the revisions and for miscellaneous/unexpected expenditures.

The approved and signed Revised/Adjusted Program of Work was received by the Agency on 11 December 2023. Copy of the approved original POW and the revised/adjusted POW is enclosed as Annexes A and A-1.



Hereunder are the details of the Accomplishment Report as of December 31, 2023.


The conduct of other PUVMP-related technical assistance was also led by the Operations Division assisted by the JO personnel under PUVMP. Some of the concerns that were extended technical assistance are but not limited to: bank application relative to the implementation of modernization, consolidation deadline, LPTRP concerns, sustaining the TC's repayment capacity on their loan obligation with the financing institution in acquiring modernized units. Aside from the technical assistance given to the TCs, the Social Support component of the program was also discussed and brochures/forms were given to TCs affected by the implementation of PUVMP Program.

As of December 31, 2023, OTC has received the cross-matching results of the Batch 1 List of beneficiaries for Entsuperneur Program and has endorsed the **One thousand one hundred fifteen (1,115)** beneficiaries to DOTr for inclusion in the benes to be endorsed to DOLE. On the other hand, OTC has forwarded to DSWD the Batch 2 List of Beneficiaries for Cross-matching.

For the Tsuper Iskolar Program, OTC was able to endorse a total of additional **One Thousand One Hundred Sixteen beneficiaries (1,116)** who are interested to enroll in the courses offered by TESDA under this program. These beneficiaries are in addition to the previously submitted Five Hundred Forty-three (543) beneficiaries prior to the transfer and implementation of the 4 Million PUVMP Funds.

The Office of Transportation Cooperatives is hopeful that these interested beneficiaries for the two programs that were endorsed to DOTr will be considered.

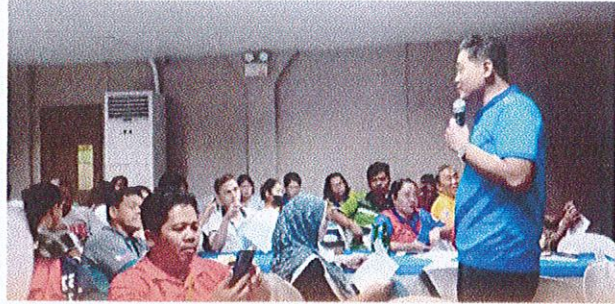

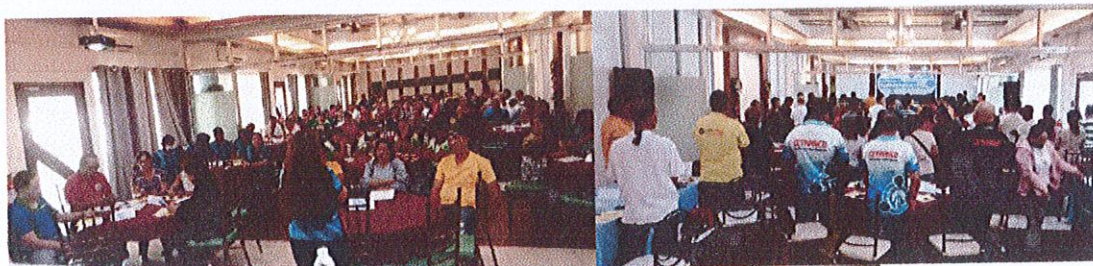
