In relation to the social support mechanism component of the Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program (PUVMP), the **Department of Transportation (DOTr)**, in partnership with the **Technical Education Skills and Development Authority (TESDA)**, recently launched a special project dubbed as the "TSUPER ISKOLAR".

The said project aims to provide free trainings with daily allowances for the affected drivers, operators, allied workers and their dependents based on their chosen courses from the list of specific trainings titles being offered by TESDA.
